According collect the bases, applications may be submitted by the Union of Journalists of Andalusia or the Spanish Federation of Journalists and other trade union and professional organization of journalists and media workers and institutions and organizations that remain outside the journalistic space agreements or partnerships with the SPA or FeSP.

Nominations submitted must be accompanied by a reasoned proposal journalist or as candidate or organization's memory, as well as your resume and any written, graphic or audiovisual documentation or links to them, which are considered appropriate for accreditation of merits.
